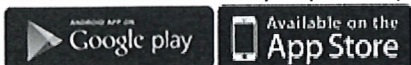
Please join RCBC in proclaiming October 21st – 27th, 2019 as National Waste Reduction Week in Canada and lending your support!

Dear Mayor and Council,

I am writing today about an exciting opportunity to realize the launch of the Good Apple Project, an idea that has been two years in the making.

As you may know, Grendel Group has a juice presser and has hosted Apple Gladness Day in Smithers for the past two years, with the next event happening this Friday September 6. They lent their equipment to the Telkwa Community Initiatives Society (TCIS) for a one day event last year and this year TCIS is having a week long Apple Festival. They have contracted with me to organize this event for them, which includes a Gleaning Program. The Festival is happening September 14 to September 22 and is funded by Wetzink'kwa and BearSmart BC.

I am proposing a Community Juicing Day in New Hazelton, preferably at the Hazelton Farmers Market on the final day of the season, Sunday, September 27 from 10 am to 2 pm. The event would be coordinated by myself and other volunteers who step forward. An important element of the event is to promote BearSmart safety tips and I am hoping to have local wildlife biologist Debbie Wellwood come give a short talk and set up a table with take home information.

To cover the costs of this event including juicing equipment, a speaker honorarium for Debbie, and a coordinator honorarium for myself, I am fundraising with a goal of \$500. I am applying to the Credit Union and am

requesting that the District of New Hazelton consider a \$250 contribution. There will be other opportunities to participate in the event, including volunteering beforehand to pick apples and during the event to help juice them.

For equipment, an alliance of local residents and non-profits have purchased a full system that requires no electricity and allows for a wide variety of fruit to be processed with greater efficiency and with easy clean up. I am attaching information on this system for your information.

This is a terrific start for the Good Apple Project and I am hoping that if we can do a pilot project this year, that next year we can grow the event to include more activities using the Telkwa Festival as inspiration.

Thank you for considering this request.

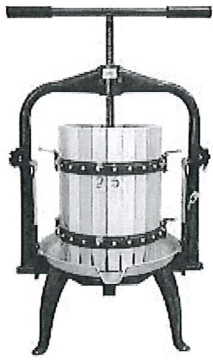

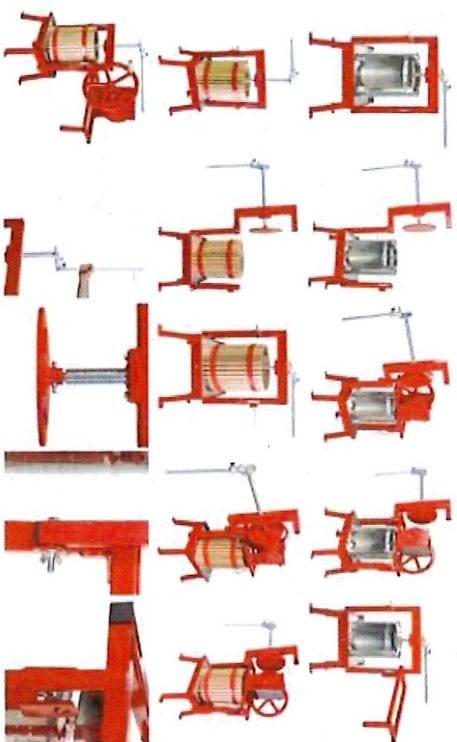
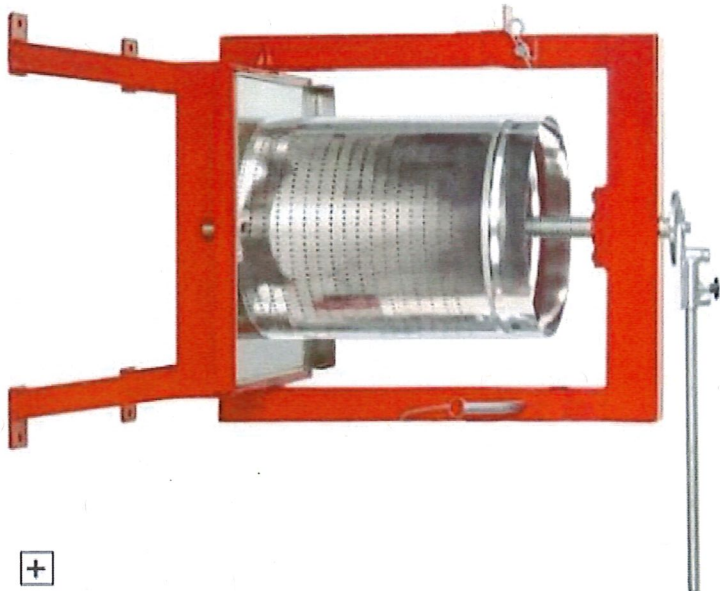
