# WATER USE RESTRICTIONS - TEMPORARY

### **System maintenance: March 12- 20, 2026**

Water reservoirs for the South Hazelton Water System will be taken offline to complete necessary maintenance and cleaning from **March 12<sup>th</sup> to March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026**.

Reservoir maintenance and cleaning is critical to system water quality. Due to the system's limited storage capacity, **we are asking residents to temporarily conserve water** during this period to help prevent service interruptions.

### **How to conserve water:**

- Flush toilets only when necessary
- Reduce shower times
- Keep a water jug in the fridge to avoid running the tap for cold water
- Use a dishwasher instead of handwashing, if possible
- Don't leave taps running
- Only wash full loads of laundry
- Avoid washing vehicles if possible
- Avoid washing buildings, driveways, or patios
- Do not fill swimming pools

If you notice you have low water pressure or any cloudiness in your water during this timeframe, please notify the RDKS as soon as possible at 250-615-6100.
